We have been closely monitoring the dynamic and rapidly evolving Coronavirus (COVID-19) pandemic and the impact it is having on our communities. "Definitions and Exemptions", Dahl's Equipment Rentals is claiming an exemption to the shelter in place order as individuals who perform work necessary to the operations and maintenance of "Essential Infrastructure" and therefore **OUR BUSINESS WILL REMAIN OPEN TO SERVE OUR CUSTOMERS' NEEDS DURING THIS CRISIS.**
