

Coronavirus COVID-19 Update



April 8, 2020

To our Valued Customers, Vendors, Neighbors and Partners,

We have been closely monitoring the dynamic and rapidly evolving Coronavirus (COVID-19) pandemic and the impact it is having on our communities. In accordance with guidance from public health experts and the CDC, we are all doing our part to mitigate the spread of the coronavirus by practicing social distancing, good hand hygiene, and respiratory etiquette. (including washing our hands correctly and frequently, avoiding touching our faces, sneezing into elbows, and frequently using hand sanitizer) At Dahl's Equipment Rentals, the safety and security of our employees, customers, vendors, partners, and neighbors is our utmost priority and our deep sympathies are with those impacted by this tragedy.

On Monday March 16, 2020 under the authority of California Health and Safety Code Sections 101040, 101085, and 120175 the Health Officer of the County of Santa Clara County announced a "shelter in place" order for all residents which is to take effect at 12:01 AM on March 17, 2020.

Under section 10.C. "Definitions and Exemptions", Dahl's Equipment Rentals is claiming an exemption to the shelter in place order as individuals who perform work necessary to the operations and maintenance of "Essential Infrastructure" and therefore **OUR BUSINESS WILL REMAIN OPEN TO SERVE OUR CUSTOMERS' NEEDS DURING THIS CRISIS.**

Later, on March 31, 2020 the County of Santa Clara Public Health Department amended the existing shelter in place order to establish guidelines that mandate social distancing protocols for all companies who are claiming an exemption and remaining open for business. In accordance with this amendment, we have posted our protocol along with the required signage at all of our facility entrances. Additionally, we have;

- Taken measures to protect our employees' and customers' health and posted the specific efforts being made to do so
- Implemented controls to prevent crowds from gathering while conducting business at our location
- Setup constraints that help people remain at least six feet apart
- Altered our operating procedures and provisions to prevent unnecessary physical contact
- Increased the frequency and overall labors to sanitize all interaction areas in the facility

It is our strong belief that continuing to support the public and private institutions that ensure we all have waste disposal, internet services, communications, electricity, heat, and water in our homes is critical to our goal of overcoming this outbreak. We also believe that uniting our neighborhoods through solidarity, dedication, and compassion will help us all get through the greatest challenge of our generation and ultimately emerge from it a stronger and more vibrant community.

Our business hours will remain the same; 7:00 AM to 5:00 PM Monday through Saturday and if additional mandates are placed upon us that effect our operations, we will send out notifications immediately thereafter. 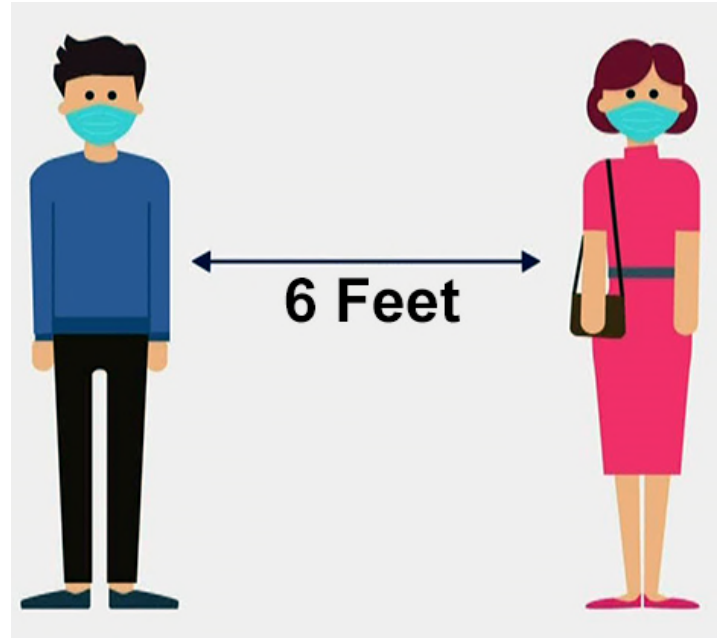
